The NASCAR Foundation continued to build hope for pediatric cancer patients by building two backyard playsets for children battling cancer. 3. We delivered 2,000 Speedy Bears to kids in 50 hospitals on National Teddy Bear Day, an especially important initiative during the COVID-19 pandemic. 4. Our Speediatrics Fun Day Festivals continued in 7 markets with a modified program to adhere to COVID-19 protocols in each market. 5. The NASCAR Foundation provided 150,000 pounds of food and emergency supplies to 3,400 families in 4 race markets through a partnership with Convoy of Hope and Joey Logano Foundation. 6. Children in Talladega enjoyed a beautiful day outside to participate in our Speediatrics Fun Day Festival at Lincoln Elementary School.
